## TECHNICAL OUTLOOK

### Nifty50: Rally Pauses at a Crucial Juncture – Time for Selective Trading

After staging an impressive rally of more than 1,000 points in just six trading sessions, Nifty50 witnessed profit booking on the last trading day of the week. Weakness in the IT sector emerged as the biggest drag for index, leading to intraday sharp cuts and halting the recent momentum. Technically, the index is now placed at a critical zone where caution is required, as several indicators suggest that Nifty50 is approaching a make-or-break level. The Relative Strength Index (RSI) on the daily timeframe has consistently failed to enter the high-momentum territory above 60 since January 2026. Once again, the indicator has faced rejection near the same zone, indicating that bullish momentum is yet to gain complete control. Another important hurdle remains the 100-day Exponential Moving Average (DEMA). Since 23rd February 2026, the index has been unable to sustain above this key average, and once again it has acted as a strong resistance. A decisive close above the 100 DEMA is essential for the ongoing momentum to continue and for bulls to regain control. On the downside, the unfilled gap around the 23,650 zone could provide a cushion and offer a buying opportunity to short-term traders. As long as this support remains intact, dips can be viewed as opportunities rather than reasons to panic. Going forward, traders should focus on price action near these key levels. While the Nifty50 index may remain range-bound until a breakout is witnessed, sectors such as Tourism, Defence, and Small Caps are displaying relative strength and could continue to offer attractive momentum trading opportunities.

### Levels to watch

The immediate support can be expected in 23,800-23,780 range and close below the level could further drag the index towards gap area placed in 23,645-23,630 trading range.

On the flip side, the hurdle can be expected in 24,140-24,160 trading range which also coincides with 100 DEMA. The trade and close above this range could result in fresh momentum and rally can extend till 24,330 and 24,500 levels.

## TECHNICAL OUTLOOK

### Bank Nifty near crucial breakout zone – Momentum Favouring Bulls

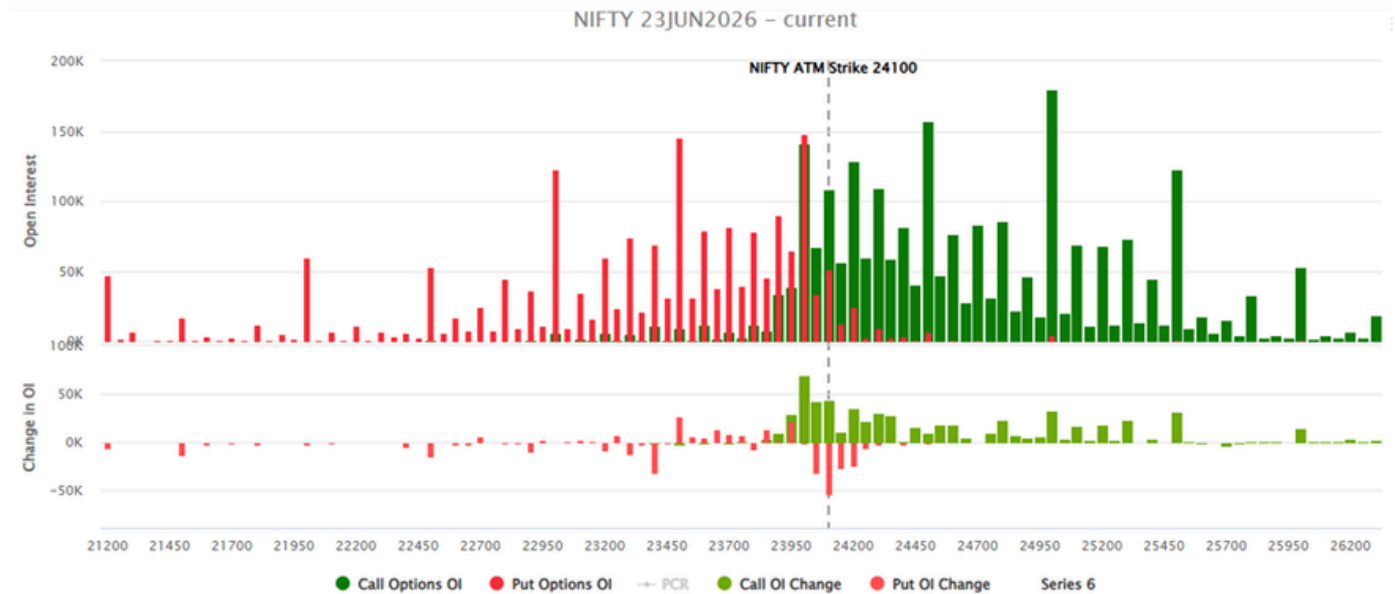
Bank Nifty continues to outperform the Nifty50, reflecting the strength and leadership of the banking space in the current market environment. The index is now approaching a critical resistance zone, where a decisive breakout could pave the way for fresh momentum in the coming sessions. One of the key technical factors to watch is the gap created during the sharp gap-down opening on 9th March 2026. After weeks of consolidation, Bank Nifty has once again approached near this supply zone. A successful move above the current levels would not only fill the gap but could also trigger a fresh round of buying interest. Momentum indicators are already supporting the positive outlook. The Relative Strength Index (RSI) is comfortably trading in the positive zone, indicating that buyers continue having an upper hand. Moreover, the index is sustaining above all major short-term moving averages, reinforcing the short term positive sentiments. The rally is being led by select private sector banks, which are displaying strong relative strength and are likely to continue offering attractive trading opportunities. In contrast, PSU banks, after witnessing a recent pull back, may enter a phase of consolidation or a minor pause before resuming their broader trend.

### Levels to watch

The recent gap area could provide support to the index in 56,800-56,770 range and violation of the range could further drag the prices towards 100 EMA (56,018). The fresh base for the index can be expected in 55,260-55,230 trading range.

On the other hand, the “Doji” pattern in weekly time frame suggest, the fresh momentum can be expected once index trades and close above 58,120-58,150 range and in that case the move can be expected towards 58,850 and 59,400 levels.

### The following information can be obtained from option data

- 1) The 24,000 zone could act as key level in immediate short term. The call and put option both in this strike holds significant open interest and unwinding in one would decide the immediate short term trend
- 2) The next significant OI is placed in 24,500 CE and it could act as major resistance area.
- 3) The put call ratio (PCR) at 0.78 suggests, index has room for further upside but price breakout is required.

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## वैश्विक संकेत सकारात्मक, अब नजर निफ्टी के निर्णायक स्तरों पर

**घटती अस्थिरता, नरम पड़ती तेल कीमतें और बैंकिंग शेयरों की मजबूती ने बाजार का भरोसा बढ़ाया है।** हालांकि अगले चरण की तेजी के लिए अभी कुछ महत्वपूर्ण बाधाओं को पार करना बाकी है। पिछले कुछ सप्ताहों में भारतीय शेयर बाजार का मिजाज तेजी से बदला है। कुछ समय पहले तक जहां निवेशक वैश्विक तनाव, ऊंची अस्थिरता और आर्थिक अनिश्चितताओं को लेकर सतर्क नजर आ रहे थे, वहीं अब तस्वीर पहले की तुलना में कहीं अधिक संतुलित दिखाई दे रही है। हालिया कारोबारी सत्रों में आई मजबूती ने यह संकेत दिया है कि बाजार में जोखिम लेने की क्षमता लौट रही है। हालांकि यह भी उतना ही सच है कि हाल की तेजी के बाद बाजार अब ऐसे मोड़ पर पहुंच चुका है जहां आगे की दिशा तय करने के लिए उसे नई ऊर्जा की आवश्यकता होगी।

बाजार के पक्ष में सबसे बड़ा बदलाव निवेशकों की मानसिकता में देखने को मिला है। **India Vix में करीब 12 प्रतिशत की गिरावट यह दर्शाती है कि बाजार में डर का स्तर तेजी से कम हुआ है।** भू-राजनीतिक मोर्चे पर हालात अपेक्षाकृत शांत होने और वैश्विक अनिश्चितताओं के कम होने से निवेशकों का भरोसा मजबूत हुआ है। जब अस्थिरता घटती है तो बाजार का ध्यान नकारात्मक खबरों से हटकर विकास और कमाई की संभावनाओं पर केंद्रित होने लगता है।

अंतरराष्ट्रीय संकेत भी घरेलू बाजारों के लिए सहायक बने हुए हैं। **डॉव जॉंस और नैस्डैक अपने रिकॉर्ड उच्च स्तरों के आसपास कारोबार कर रहे हैं,** वहीं कमोडिटी बाजार में भी एक दिलचस्प बदलाव देखने को मिला है। **सोना और चांदी में हालिया कमजोरी की प्रमुख वजह मजबूत अमेरिकी डॉलर, बढ़ती बॉन्ड यील्ड्स और ब्याज दरों में कटौती को लेकर घटती उम्मीदें हैं।** फेडरल रिजर्व के सख्त रुख की संभावना ने डॉलर को मजबूती दी है, जिसका सीधा असर कीमती धातुओं पर पड़ा है। इसके बावजूद **भारतीय रुपया अपेक्षाकृत स्थिर बना हुआ है,** जो घरेलू आर्थिक मजबूती का संकेत माना जा सकता है। भारत जैसे ऊर्जा आयातक देश के लिए एक और राहत भरी खबर कच्चे तेल से आई है। **कच्चे तेल की कीमतों में लगभग 10 प्रतिशत की गिरावट भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था और बाजार दोनों के लिए सकारात्मक संकेत है।**

घरेलू बाजार के भीतर भी तस्वीर पहले की तुलना में कहीं अधिक संतुलित दिखाई दे रही है। हाल के महीनों में जहां निवेशक केवल कुछ बड़े शेयरों तक सीमित दिखाई दे रहे थे, वहीं अब व्यापक बाजार में भी भागीदारी बढ़ने लगी है। **मिडकैप और स्मॉलकैप शेयरों में फिर से रुचि दिखाई दे रही है,** जो यह संकेत देता है कि निवेशक आर्थिक गतिविधियों और कॉर्पोरेट आय वृद्धि को लेकर अधिक आश्वस्त हैं। हालांकि उत्साह के बीच कुछ सावधानियां भी जरूरी हैं। **हालिया तेजी के बाद बाजार अब ऐसे स्तरों पर पहुंच चुका है जहां मुनाफावसूली स्वाभाविक मानी जाएगी।** यही कारण है कि आने वाले दिनों में निवेशकों को अंधाधुंध खरीदारी के बजाय चयनात्मक दृष्टिकोण अपनाने की आवश्यकता होगी। **बाजार का अगला चरण उन्हीं शेयरों और सेक्टरों के नेतृत्व में आगे बढ़ सकता है जहां वास्तविक मजबूती दिखाई दे रही है।** तकनीकी दृष्टि से निफ्टी अब एक महत्वपूर्ण दहलीज पर खड़ा है। **24,140 से 24,160 का क्षेत्र निफ्टी के लिए सबसे महत्वपूर्ण प्रतिरोध बना हुआ है,** जहां से पिछले कई महीनों में बाजार को बार-बार दबाव का सामना करना पड़ा है। दूसरी ओर **23,800 से 23,780 का क्षेत्र निकट अवधि का महत्वपूर्ण समर्थन माना जा रहा है।** जब तक यह आधार सुरक्षित है, तब तक हर गिरावट को कमजोरी नहीं बल्कि अवसर के रूप में देखा जा सकता है। डेरिवेटिव बाजार भी फिलहाल संतुलित लेकिन सकारात्मक संकेत दे रहा है। **24,000 का स्तर बुल्स और बेयर्स के बीच सबसे महत्वपूर्ण संघर्ष क्षेत्र बनकर उभरा है,** जबकि 24,500 के आसपास मजबूत प्रतिरोध मौजूद है। वहीं 0.78 का PCR यह संकेत देता है कि बाजार में तेजी की संभावनाएं अभी समाप्त नहीं हुई हैं, लेकिन अगले चरण की चाल के लिए कीमतों को निर्णायक ब्रेकआउट दिखाना होगा। यदि हालिया तेजी का सबसे बड़ा लाभार्थी कोई क्षेत्र रहा है तो वह बैंकिंग सेक्टर है। **निजी क्षेत्र के बैंक फिलहाल बाजार में नेतृत्वकर्ता की भूमिका निभा रहे हैं और उनकी मजबूती ने पूरे बाजार को सहारा दिया है।** बैंक निफ्टी अब एक ऐसे क्षेत्र के करीब पहुंच चुका है जहां से नई तेजी की शुरुआत हो सकती है। **58,120 से 58,150 के ऊपर टिकने पर बैंक निफ्टी में नई गति देखने को मिल सकती है,** जिससे व्यापक बाजार को भी मजबूती मिलने की संभावना है।

वैश्विक संकेतों में सुधार, घटती अस्थिरता, मजबूत बैंकिंग शेयर, स्थिर रुपया और नरम पड़ती तेल कीमतें बाजार के पक्ष में खड़ी नजर आती हैं। ऐसे माहौल में सूचकांकों की दिशा से अधिक महत्वपूर्ण यह होगा कि निवेशक सही क्षेत्रों की पहचान कर सकें। **Tourism, Defence और Small Cap सेगमेंट में फिलहाल सबसे मजबूत Relative Strength दिखाई दे रही है,** और यदि मौजूदा माहौल बना रहता है तो आने वाले सप्ताहों में बाजार का नेतृत्व इन्हीं क्षेत्रों से निकलता हुआ दिखाई दे सकता है।

## EDUCATION CORNER/ FINANCIAL TERMINOLOGY

### WHAT ARE CAPITAL GAINS?????

Capital gains are the **profit you make when you sell an asset for more than you paid for it.**

- Capital gains refer to the profit earned when a capital asset, such as real estate, stocks, bonds, or other investments, is sold for a price higher than its original purchase price. The gain is the difference between the asset's purchase price and its selling price, resulting in a financial benefit to the investor.

***Capital Gain = Sale Price – Cost of Acquisition – Expenses Related to Sale***

### ASSETS THAT CAN GENERATE CAPITAL GAINS:

Capital gains can arise from selling:

- Stocks and bonds
- Real estate
- Mutual funds and ETFs
- Cryptocurrencies
- Valuable collectibles (art, coins, etc.)

### TYPES OF CAPITAL GAINS:

#### 1. Short-term capital gains

- Asset held for a relatively short period (often one year or less, depending on the country's tax rules).
- Usually taxed at a higher rate.

#### 2. Long-term capital gains

- Asset held for a longer period (often more than one year).
- Often taxed at a lower rate.

**Example:** Suppose XYZ Buy shares for ₹1,00,000, Pay brokerage of ₹500, Sell the shares for ₹1,30,000, Pay brokerage on sale of ₹500

**Capital Gain = ₹1,30,000 – ₹1,00,000 – ₹1,000 = ₹ 29,000**

### REALIZED VS. UNREALIZED CAPITAL GAINS:

**Unrealized Capital Gain-** Own an asset that has increased in value, but haven't sold it yet.

Example: Bought a stock at ₹100, Current market price is ₹150

- Gain = ₹50 (unrealized)

**Realized Capital Gain -** Actually sell the asset and lock in the profit.

Example: Bought at ₹100, Sold at ₹150

- Gain = ₹50 (realized)

*Taxes generally apply only to realized gains.*

*Capital gains represent the profit earned from the sale of a capital asset at a price higher than its purchase price. They are an important source of investment income and can arise from the sale of both tangible assets, such as stocks, bonds, and real estate, and intangible assets, such as goodwill. Understanding capital gains is essential for investors, as they directly impact investment returns and tax liabilities.*

### IPO- TURTLEMINT FINTECH SOLUTIONS LTD
